biography

Ina Wudtke (born 1968) is a Berlin-based artist. She obtained her master's degree (Diplom) 1995 at the Academy of Fine Arts in Hamburg. Her research-driven work challenges dominant political narratives around labor, gender, housing, and colonial legacies. She is a founding member of the queer-feminist collective NEID and edited from 1992–2004 the eponymous magazine. With Dieter Lesage, she wrote the book *Black Sound White Cube* (Vienna, Loecker, 2010). In 2011, she released the concept album *The Fine Art of Living* under her pseudonym T-INA Darling. In 2018, she published a book of the same title on her artistic work about the housing question (Berlin, Archive Books). From 2015 to 2021, together with Thomas Kilpper she ran *after the butcher. exhibition space for contemporary art and social issues*. From 2018 to 2020, she was artistic researcher for documenta professor Dr. Nora Sternfeld at the Art Academy in Kassel. In 2022 her book *Worker Writers* was published by Motto Books, Berlin. In the publication *BLACK STUDIUM. A Tribute to Fasia Jansen, Hilarius Gilges & Joseph Ekwe Bilé* (Berlin, Scriptings, 2024 and as E-Pub, Berlin, ECCLECTIC 2025), she continues her research on the workers movement, uncovers traces of the history of Black people in Germany and multidirectionally recalls past and present anti-racist struggles. In 2024, she was awarded the Max Kade/Charlotte M. Craig Fellowship at Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey USA.
